

Dear Key Stage 2 Parents,

As you know today we hosted a special internet safety assembly as part of the Google Legends Tour. The tour aims to keep children safe online by giving them the tools they need to make the internet work for them. We hope that by bringing Google into school we will have educated and inspired our pupils about this important topic. Google, in partnership with Parent Zone, have consulted a panel of experts and academics to advise on the content for this digital literacy campaign and subsequently developed the Internet Legends theme and assembly.

The Internet Legends assembly introduced the pupils to the Legends Code, four simple guidelines for staying safe and having fun online. They are:

- 1) Think before you share.
- 2) Protect your stuff.
- 3) Check it's for real.
- 4) Respect each other.

Please do talk to your children about today's assembly and the content covered.
