

Tom and Ed's Fun Club is a Breakfast and After School Club.

The Club is provided for children of Thomas Reade and St Edmund's primary schools and is located at Thomas Reade Primary School, which is also on Radley Road.

The Breakfast Club is open from 7.30am and is £5.25 per first child and £5.00 for siblings.

The After School Club is open from 3.00pm – 5.55pm and is £9.50 per first child and £9.00 per sibling.

St Edmund's pupils are dropped off by their parents at the breakfast club and then Tom & Eds staff walk the children to St Edmund's school in time for the gates opening at 8:40am.

At the end of the school day (3pm) St Edmund's pupils are registered in the school hall by Tom & Eds staff who then walk them to Tom & Eds Fun Club. Parents then collect from the Club at Thomas Reade school before 5:55pm.

The Club is run and organised by staff at Thomas Reade school and places are allocated on a first come first served basis for pupils at either school.
